- 1. Pray for our president and his team as they lead us through this crisis.
- 2. Pray for our government—national, state, and local leaders—who are managing through these tough times.
- 3. Pray for all people who are infected with COVID-19 and those in quarantine.
- 4. Pray for people who are at higher risk of developing the disease.
- 5. Pray for a cure for this virus, that the virus will be stopped.
- 6. Pray for healthcare workers, medical professionals, and caregivers who are working with those infected.
- 7. Pray for the staff and leadership of [your church] as they navigate through these troubled times.
- 8. Pray for the ministries of [your church] as they look very different and unique in these times.
- 9. Pray for those who have lost jobs or income because of this virus and may be facing some difficult days. Pray that God would provide for all their needs (Phil 4:19). Pray for the recovery of our economy and jobs.
- 10. Pray by name for specific people that you know who are being impacted by this crisis.
- 11. Pray that God will provide the financial resources needed to fulfill [your church's] mission and ministry in the community.
- 12. Pray that we will all be sensitive to the needs of those around us and that we will seize the opportunity to help those in need.
- 13. Pray that a spirit of faith would overcome a spirit of fear (2 Tm 1:7).
- 14. Pray for online outreach ministry efforts while churches and missions organizations can't meet in person.
- 15. Pray for God to send a great awakening during these days and that we will take advantage of these unprecedented opportunity to share the gospel with others.
- 16. Pray for the other churches in your community in your denomination and its leadership. Pray for missionaries as they are serving around the globe in these tough times.
- 17. Pray for those who will suffer from anxiety and depression as we face these unknown days.
- 18. Pray that we will count it all joy as we face these trials (James 1:2–8).
- 19. Pray that God will draw us closer to Him in these days (James 4:8).
