

Session Descriptions

Free Salvation for All Men (Stan Key)

The biblical record is the story of the brokenness, disobedience, and total depravity of the human condition, and the activity of the self-disclosing, self-giving, holy God who acts in history for the redemption and eternal salvation of humankind. The distinctive witness of Scripture is that God does for us what we could never do for ourselves.

Sin's Two-fold Problem (Chris Bounds)

To save us from our sins, Jesus must set us free from our personal sins and the sins committed against us. This session explore will the two-fold problem of sin—the sins we commit and the sins committed against us.

Salvation through Jesus' Deity (Chris Bounds)

Christ saves us from our sins through his deity. This session will explore how Christ in his deity saves us from of sin's two-fold problem.

Salvation through Jesus' Humanity (Chris Bounds)

Christ saves us from our sins through his humanity. This session will explore how Christ as the second Adam saves us from sin's two-fold problem.

Christ saves us from our sins through the cross and resurrection. This session will explore who Christ's resurrection and exaltation makes possible full salvation from the two-fold problem of sin.
